Members reviewed the following;

- > Accounts for the first 9 months of the financial year.
- > Projected Income/Expenditure for the financial year ending 31st March.
- Budget for the financial year starting 1st April 20167. The Chairman had carried out a considerable amount of work on these figures which he presented to Members. Cllr's G. Pennington and S. Schofield had also assisted on this. He explained how the £75,000 from the Wrekin Housing Trust had been allocated to various headings under Ear Marked reserves. A more detailed breakdown of grounds maintenance would be included in next year's accounts along with discussions with Stans Superstore on the next three year lease of the field and for the street lighting committee to consider a project to upgrade street lights to LED in selected areas of the village. The Chairman added that his projection for surplus funds at the 31st March 2017 was around £2,500 should be considered for a first step towards a budget for devolved services.

022/01/17.F Budget/Precept 2017/18

The Parish Clerk explained that Shropshire Council had stated that in order to show a 0% increase in the Band D Council Tax charge on the 2017/18 Council Tax Demand Notices the parish council precept requirement for 2017/18 would need to be £50,199 compared to £49,189 requested in 2016/17. This was due to the taxbase increasing between 2016/17 and 2017/18 by 2.05%. After discussion it was;
