168/09/18.C Ifton Meadows Nature Reserve

Cllr's were asked to consider concerns from residents over cattle grazing on Ifton Meadows.

Some Cllr's felt this was again a cost cutting exercise by Shropshire Council. This area was used by children and many dog owners walking their dogs. Concern was also expressed that there was no water supply for such animals, it was a public open space and a protected area for birds.

It was felt that the village people should be consulted on this.

Agreed to invite Shaun Burkey from Shropshire Council to the next meeting to explain in more detail their plans for this area.

169/09/18.C Street Lighting

Cllr B. Herbert reported a number of lights out between the school and Gledrid Roundabout.

The Parish Clerk reported that there had been a number of outstanding issues to the repair of Street Lights. Although the lights along Overton Road and Ellesmere Road belong to Shropshire Council, they seem to take a long time to repair a fault.

All other lights belong to the Parish Council and when a fault is reported these are usually repaired within a week by our contractors Highline Electrical. However faults in Cherry Tree Drive have been mainly caused by utility companies working in the area and damaging the underground power cables. When this happens Scottish Power have to repair the fault who send the majority of their work to a subcontractor. The Street Lighting Committee will now be looking at a number of quotations to convert all the street lights owned by the Parish Council to LED.

The Parish Clerk had now received a quotation from Eon for the conversion of all lights to LED. This along with the quotation from Highline Electrical would be considered by the Street Lighting Committee.
